

Homework

Homework is meant to reinforce what is taught in the classroom; a way to connect classroom learning to home. Our goal is to keep it relevant to what we want our students to learn and master. It should not take more than 45 minutes to complete.

A “weekly schedule” will be sent home outlining the next week’s assignments/assessments. These are subject to change. The students are responsible for copying all homework information into their agendas.

An incomplete homework assignment may result in loss of recess time. Three missed assignments per quarter may result in after school detention.

Grading Policy

Quizzes, tests, and performance tasks are given on a regular basis in all subject areas. These are logged into MMS. Let us know if you need access to log in to MMS. Homework may occasionally be graded-this will be announced. The 4th grade adheres to the District grading scale.

Discipline Plan

Discipline will be maintained within all school areas. Inappropriate behaviors will not be tolerated. Your child will be expected to show respect for themselves, their peers, adults, and school property. Classroom and school rules are posted and discussed. Whole class and individual behavior management strategies will be incorporated as needed.

Typical Consequences

1. Verbal warning
2. Five-ten minutes loss of recess
3. Loss of entire recess
4. Parent contact
5. Discipline slip sent to office

Positive Reinforcement

Positive behavior will be modeled, reinforced, and rewarded. An enjoyable learning experience is what we’re after and this requires good behavior. Each teacher has their own individual methods of behavior management which promote acceptable behaviors.
