Dear 3rd, 4th, 5th, and 6th Grade Families,

This letter is to inform you that your child(ren) will be taking the Pennsylvania System of School Assessment (PSSA). The PSSA's are a statewide testing system designed to assess each child's ability within their given grade level. The information obtained from the assessments serves as valuable tools for planning future school programs, developing curriculum and in-service training of teachers, informing the public about student achievement, and gaining our school's School Performance Profile Score. Each assessment will yield individual student reports, as well as school, district, and state data.

The following is the 2023 Fort Cherry Elementary Testing Schedule:

Grade 3-6	PSSA English Language Arts	April 23, 24, & 25	9:15 – 11:00
Grade 3-6	PSSA Math	April 28 & 29	9:15 – 11:00
Grade 4	PSSA Science	April 30 & May 1	9:15 – 11:00

Due to the importance of every child's participation during the assessment dates, we ask that parents attempt to have their child(ren) <u>at school on time</u>, <u>do not dismiss them during testing times for any appointments</u>, <u>and make the school aware of extenuating circumstances that may interfere with attendance during the above dates</u>.

In addition, all students will have as much as needed throughout the designated school day to complete the test section being administered. Any student not finishing by 11:00 will be moved to an overflow room for test completion. Due to the strict security rules elicited by the Pennsylvania Department of Education, no student is allowed to have any electronic devices in the testing area. Therefore, no electronic devices other than school-issued devices will be allowed out at school for the dates listed above (ie: smart watches & cell phones). If a student does not abide by this rule disciplinary action will be taken. This does NOT apply to diabetic devices.

Parents may assist their child(ren) in preparing for the assessments by encouraging them to get plenty of sleep the night before and providing a healthy breakfast the morning of the testing. We will be offering breakfast as well. Also, parents can reassure their child(ren) that the assessment gives them an opportunity to demonstrate their learning and help teachers develop appropriate instruction. They should put forth their best effort.




