




Submitting an Absence Excuse on the Sapphire Community Portal

Dear Families.

We are excited to share with you our school-wide behavior system that we are implementing! PBIS (Positive Behavioral Interventions & Support) is a framework to promote and maximize academic achievement and behavioral competence. It is a school-wide strategy for helping all students achieve important social and learning goals. We know that when good behavior and good teaching come together, our students will excel in their learning.

Fort Cherry Elementary School is proud to be a part of this exciting initiative. As part of the PBIS framework, we have established clear rules for the behaviors we expect in all areas of our school. These expectations are explained in our behavior matrix, which you will find on the back.

We will teach and reteach these expectations to the students throughout the school year. Our staff will verbally and visually acknowledge students' appropriate behaviors by giving them a RANGER PRIDE TICKET for being RESPECTFUL, RESPONSIBLE and RESILIENT. Students will add their ticket to the Rangers' 200 Club poster. When 10 students are in a row, students will have a chance to spin a wheel for a prize.

In order for PBIS to be successful at Fort Cherry Elementary, we need your help! Below is a list of suggestions of how you can support PBIS.

PBIS AT HOME

*Remind your child of the behavioral expectations on a daily basis.

*Review the following before leaving for school...

Be Respectful – I will treat each person the way I want to be treated.

Be Responsible – I will do the right thing even when no one is watching.

Be Resilient- I will perform my best because I am prepared.

*Use the same language that is being used at school with your child.

*Review the behavior matrix on the back.

*Ask your child if he/she has received a RANGER PRIDE TICKET and why they got it.

*Reinforce positive behaviors that your child is showing at school.
