Pupil Service Update:

Teachers are continued to be trained on Indicator 13 per recommendations from State Audit and attempting to be proactive with IEP creation.

Fort Cherry hosted Quiz Bowl on Thursday we had a total of 10 teams of 4/5 graders from Washington, Chartiers Houston, McGuffey, Burgettstown, Avella, and Canon Mac. Trinity had to cancel due to flooding in Washington. Two Canon Mac teams placed 1st and 2nd - Avella placed 3rd. The FC team answered a lot of questions and had a good experience. Matt Parson had students design and create the awards for the top three teams.

Technology:

- DJ Hoy, in addition to Onsite tickets, operated the student tech office for Chromebook repairs and troubleshooting of student devices.
- DJ Hoy assisted Johnson Controls with access to closets so they could evaluate switches/cameras.
- CCL repaired 4 Chromebooks sent in for parts/repairs.
- CCL received report that Ms. Cindy Baker was experiencing slow internet speeds. We implemented PRTG monitoring of network to aid in researching as well as testing wireless network. Results showed low bandwidth usage from District firewall. Hickory Telephone Company (Internet Provider) was called to line test and remove bandwidth cap. CCL is working with DJ to ensure Chromebooks have the latest updates. Keeping in contact with Ms. Baker to see if experiencing further issues.
- CCL assisted administration in completing eRate submission as well as writing bid specifications and hardware requirements for the eRate PEPPM mini-bid.
