- 2. There has been two different training sessions for Mrs. Alicia Shea (Reading Specialist) conducted by Dr. Tracey Czajowski to implement Kid Writing at the K-2 Level.
- 3. There will be a 1/2 day Heggerty Training for K-6 and a 1/2 day Kid Writing Training for K-2 during In-Service.
- 4. There will be an online training for K-6 for Illustrative Math curriculum during In-Service.
- 5. The updated Attendance Policy has been reviewed and discussed in grades K-6.

Pupil Services/Technology

Destiny (library catalog) Migration: The district migrated its Destiny server to cloud-based service, eliminating the need for an outdated server, while providing ongoing updates throughout.

ProSoft Financial: ProSoft Financial is migrated to cloud-based service. Users now have access to this service, eliminating the need for the on-site server.

Multi-Factor Authentication: Enrollment details have been sent to all users to begin the setup process of Multi-Factor Authentication.

Schoology: The District's new Learning Management System, Schoology, is fully functional, with twice daily updates for student enrollments and schedules. Train the trainer session was held on August 17. These trainers will train district staff during in-service week.

One2One Manager: The District's new device inventory control system, One2One Manager, is fully functional.

All Chromebooks and iPads are distributed to classrooms in preparation for the first day. Insurance is being offered to all students, and enrollments are due on September 4.
