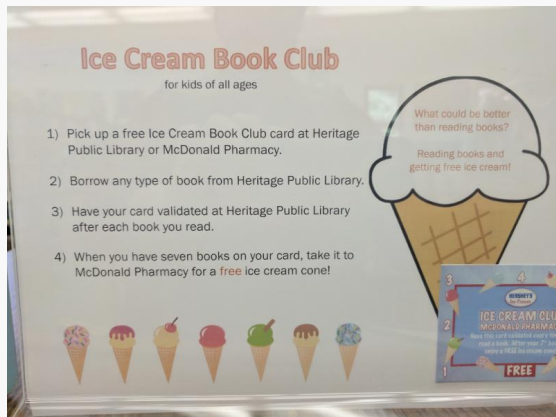
## *Heal Yourself: Heal the World, Reiki Workshop*
